

## TRANSPORTATION AND RESTAURANTS

### ***Transportation***

If you don't have a car at the tournament, you can still get around at minimal expense. Dinner, shopping and the movies are all available via the City of Grapevine shuttle bus. An all-day pass is only five dollars. (Note: the bus driver cannot make change.)

At six minutes past the hour from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. the bus that runs along the Yellow Route of the Grapevine Visitors' Shuttle leaves the front door of the Hyatt Regency. In exactly one hour it makes a loop back to the hotel, stopping at such places as Grapevine Mills Mall, which has a ton of restaurants, a 30 screen movie theater, and many dozens of stores, and Cabela's, a hunting, fishing and outdoor goods store where the exhibits are worth a visit even if you don't intend to buy anything.

The shuttle also stops along Main Street in downtown Grapevine, where you have a couple of dozen restaurants you can walk to. Several have live music. In the restaurant lists that follows, if you see a capital S in parentheses (S), it means the restaurant is an easy walk from the shuttle.

- In-N-Out Burger - 1303 William D. Tate Avenue, Grapevine - for those who care most about the burger.
- Five Guys Burger and Fries - 242 State Street, Southlake (in Town Square) - for those who care most about the fries.
- Braum's (S) - 301 East Northwest Highway, Grapevine - for those who care most about the shake.

### ***Pizza***

- Cavalli Pizza - 3601 Regent Boulevard, Irving - please take the drive for the best pizza within 20 miles - excellent salads too - BYOB.

### ***Sandwiches***

- Weinberger's Deli (S) - 601 S. Main Street, Grapevine - Chicago style deli sandwiches.
- Schlotzsky's - 1801 South Main Street, Grapevine (south of 114).

### ***Barbecue***

- Meat-U-Anywhere - 919 W. Northwest Highway, Grapevine - get the moist brisket - my favorite in all of DFW.

### ***Indian***

- Minerva - 2410 E. Southlake Boulevard, Southlake - Outstanding North Indian food with a few South Indian specialties as well. My favorite restaurant in Southlake by far.
