ACBL Board of Directors' Report

<u>Awards</u>

President Starzec stated the Jacoby nominations ended June 30th, committee meeting to follow with award being presented at the Labor Day Regional in Dallas.

Charity

Nancy Strohmer submitted the following report:

In addition to the charity games that were held on March 22, 23, 24 and 25, the ACBL has granted D16 an additional set of games for July 12, 13, 14 and 15 due to the fact that the ACBL held special charity games March 24-31 in order to raise funds for humanitarian aid for Ukraine.

We have encouraged the clubs to participate in these games as they award 81.8% sectional-rated black points. What better time to get back to club play and support good causes at the same time!

GNT Report

Scott Nason stated that turnout was dismal. However, Kevin Perkins ran the tournament well and there was a small profit.

<u>I/N</u>

Sam Khayat submitted a report.

NAP Report

Larry Davis reported that attendance was low. Therefore, made changes to the conditions of contest to address this situation in the future. President Starzec added comments regarding better publicity in the Scorecard for both the NAP and the GNTs.

OLD BUSINESS

Ratify the following: District bank signatory, district breakfast charges, Scorecard editor increase, District will reimburse units for partial junior entry. Nancy Strohmer made a motion, which was seconded and approved.

Policy and Procedures Manual/Job Descriptions

President Starzec thanked Rachell Jackson for her excellent update. Scott Humphrey addressed an inconsistency. Every unit is supposed to get four sectionals, but San Antonio has had six due to having extra clubs. However, as clubs have closed, Scott H. recommended that the sectionals return to four. A motion was made, seconded and approved.

President Starzec emphasized that all tournament planning needs to go **first** through Scott Humphrey and then through Tourney Trax.

Scott H. also requested better guidance in scheduling tournaments than the 150 miles guideline.

BridgeWhiz

Robert Todd discussed the success of the pilot year for on-line use of Bridge Wiz, graduating 420 children (more than 50% young women) from the 20-week program. Peach Jar, which sells school email lists, was recommended as a marketing tool. A

motion was made, seconded and approved to designate \$4,000 for marketing BridgeWhiz in District 16.

Tournament Coordination

There will be a Royal STAC which Tomi Storey is working on for Nov 14-20.

NEW BUSINESS

Meeting administration

A motion was made seconded and approved to update the technology available for meetings.

Robly e-blast

Expanding use for all sectionals as well as regional tournaments to save the units money.

Lecture Series

As Austin is already running a lecture series, President Starzec asked Patricia Herrera to look into coordinating with Austin an expansion of the program to the rest of the district, as well as developing a Spanish language version.

COVID notifications

President Starzec recommended that the directors self-test prior to every tournament. Scott H. responded that he would raise this topic at the next area manager meeting.
