The Suits Never Bid

At a recent NABC there were several hands with unbid suits.

My friend Val, aka "the Mad Bulgarian", picked up the following ♠ 63 ♥ 75 ♦ AKQJ6432 ♣5.

With no one vulnerable there were 2 passes to him. Trying to maintain his American reputation he tried 2NT. Well, he did have 8 tricks. His pard transferred with ♠AQxxx and then bid 3NT. His LHO had a big hand with honors in all but diamonds, so he chanced the safe lead of a diamond!

The question was what do you call the ★AKQxxxx ? Or perhaps QJ ninth of spades? The standard answer is trumps. But at one table of a match the suits was never bid! In the first case your partner held a big 6-6 heart-diamond hand and opened 1♥. Well before you bid, the opponent on your right interjects on 1♠ and there you are. Final contract had you picking your better singleton.

Holding \triangleleft QJ10xxxxxx \forall x void \triangleleft AQx what would you bid when partner opens $4 \forall$? Unfortunately $4 \triangleleft$ would be a cue bid so the nine card spade suit comes down in dummy.
