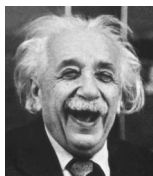

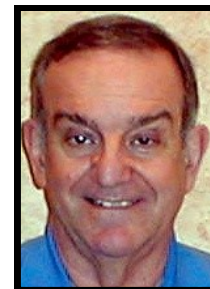

The CORRECT break is 4000. A is 4000+, B is 1250-4000, and C is 0-1250. Please be sure to help us pass along this information.
