Before you play a card with the exception of a singleton appearing in dummy, stop and ask yourself some questions.
How did the bidding go?
What did the opening lead tell you?
How many points do you have?
In a suit contract experienced players usually do not under lead an Ace, it confuses partner.
$\mathrm{AK}, \mathrm{KQ}, \mathrm{QJ}$ are considered good leads.
