

HOWARD T. WILKINS, JR. 1928 - 2009

Howard T. Wilkins, Abilene, Texas, died December 25, 2009. He was pre-deceased by his wife, Hope Duffy Wilkins, who died in December, 2006. Howard was born on April 28, 1928, in Bronte, Texas.

Howard's many accomplishments included valedictorian of his graduating class at Clyde High School in 1944. He entered McMurray College and was valedictorian of this graduating class in 1947; he also received academic honors while attending Texas University to complete his MBA. Serving two years in the Army during the Korean War, he attained the rank of Sergeant Second Class. He served as trustee at Hendrick Medical Center and Hardin-Simmons University.

Howard attained the rank of Diamond Life Master and served on many boards at the unit and district levels. Always the perfect gentleman, in 1966 he was presented with the most prestigious District 16 Award, The Oswald & James Jacoby Award, for his outstanding contribution to the promotion of bridge. All of us in the bridge world will miss him.

He is survived by two daughters, Melanie King Brown and Lisa Wilkins Laird, and one sister, Bonnie Myers, and many family members.
