



Our Future Life Masters (FLM) and 8 is enough Swiss Teams games are held monthly on Sunday at 1:30 p.m. The next games will be held on

November 10th - FLM & 8 is enough Swiss Teams

*Note:* This FLM game is *Special* where the upper limit is *99* masterpoints. It will be held separately in the Oasis room (Northwest corner of the facility).

The Swiss Teams stratifications are:

**Level 1** – 0-1000 masterpoints (1) **Level 2** – 1000-3000 masterpoints (2) **Level 3** – 3000+ masterpoints (3)

For example one Level 3, two Level 2 and one Level 1 players total 8 as would four Level 2 players. Another example would be three Level 2 and one Level 1 players whose team total is 7 and it is OK to be less than 8.



6-5, Come Alive!

So, we've all heard the adage but do we really understand what it means? Take a look at the following hand:

South's clubs aren't great but there are six of them. If North (partner) has clubs we might expect to run them after giving up a trick or two. If partner is short on clubs, they might be able to be run after ruffing one or two. That thought is sound reasoning given that opening 2♥ shows six and supporting spades shows three. With that bidding South knows nine of North's hand.

South has ♥A6 in partner's six-card suit. That, too, could be a source of tricks.

The play is straightforward. After drawing trump, end in south's hand. Lead a club toward the ♣K and lose only the A. Makes 6♠.

### Summary


Now you should understand the adage "6-5, Come Alive!" 6-5 is a powerful holding. Take some kind of action with it.

## **Communicating on Defense**

EW 4♥; EW 5♠; EW 2N; NS 1♠; Par −420: EW 4♥=

East opens 1NT. South overcalls 2♠ (showing spades and a minor). North bids 4♠ - Texas Transfer to Hearts. North bids 4♠. Should East bid? If East passes what should West do? Right or wrong West doubles.

West has the opening lead. How do you plan the defense and communicate with each other to set declarer down 3. If you only set declarer down 2, you'll have bottom board in match points because 4♥ can make.

Opening Lead: ◆A. Playing standard signals, East plays an encouraging ◆9 but West does not continue diamonds and instead plays the ♥3. West wins the ♥A.

What now? Time to count. West did not continue with diamonds even though East encouraged the suit. Why not? West must not have any more so declarer must have five diamonds including the ◆QJ. Playing the ◆K will set up declarer's diamond tricks. Play ◆3 and to let partner know to return a club after the ruff.

West ruffs the diamond, returns a club, East wins with the  $\clubsuit Q$  showing the  $\clubsuit AK$ . East follows with the  $\spadesuit 4$  setting up another ruff by West. A second club is returned which declarer ruffs. After removing trumps declarer has the  $\spadesuit QJ$  remaining but East has the  $\spadesuit K$ . So declarer can only pitch one heart and has to lose a heart to West's  $\blacktriangledown K$ .

Defensive tricks: ♦A, ♥A, ♦ruff, ♣Q, ♦ruff and ♥K. Down 3.
