Joan Jackson has been playing bridge for about fifty years, culminating on Saturday, August 31 by earning the ACBL's highest rank: Grand Life Master. In order to be a GLM, one must win a National Championship in an unrestricted NABC+ event; she has won four. One also needs 10,000 masterpoints. Joan came into the Dallas Labor Day Regional tournament needing nine points and earned them on Saturday, when her team – which included long-time GLM Bob Hamman, ACBL Executive Director Bronia Jenkins, and Cenk Tuncok – finished third in Bracket 1.

In addition to her NABC wins, Joan has a world championship to her credit. A bit Congrats to Dallas's newest Grand Life Master.



A special thanks to **Leonard Epstein** for his sound counsel regarding the April trailer theft from Public Storage. The trailer has been recovered but not all the supplies. We have replaced the supplies and moved the trailer and all our supplies to a more secure facility. We continue to pursue a fair settlement with Public Storage.

2024 has been a challenging year for the Unit. With decreased attendance at our Regional and Sectionals and increased costs, our current revenue levels are not sustainable, so we need to make some changes.

 With two Life Masters sitting East-West?

We took our positions and said not a word,
But I'm certain our heartbeats could surely be heard.
He shuffled the cards without blinking an eye,
I dopped one on the floor and thought I would die.
As North I was dealer and though I was green,
I knew to open you must have thirteen.
I spread my hand and counted but alas With only ten points I had to pass.
And frankly I thought this was a shame,
I'd never before had thirteen spades in a game.

My left hand opponent, East by name,
Opened "Two Diamonds" and I thought What a
Shame!

My partner, South, was trembling with fear,
And the bid of "Two Hearts" came across to my ear.
My right hand opponent sat straight in his chair,
"Three Hearts" was the bid he chose to declare.
Now I had a good suit, but alas With no help in Hearts, I had to pass.
My left hand opponent now bid "Three Spades,"
You can imagine how I was amazed.



My partner, South, bid "Four Hearts" and shoot, If they take the bid I couldn't lead her best suit.

My right hand opponent studied his hand, And soon "Seven No Trump" was his command. It was my time to bid and just to save face, I doubled 'cause I knew they were missing the Spade Ace.

The next three bids were Pass, Pass, Pass
So I was ready to lead a Spade, but alas My partner was nervous and she led the Heart King.
A lead out of turn — what a damnable thing

The Director was called and I can still hear his voice,
As he told the Declarer he could make his own choice.
With a singleton Heart, you must understand,
This could be the only entry to his hand;
So he turned to me and looking real smart,
He said, "Lead any suit, but don't lead a Heart."
So of course, I led my fourth best Spade,
I guess it was the best lead I ever made.
Cause in this hand I never lost the lead,
